I have been following the progress of the Inquiry into fracing (albeit not closely) and, with the release of the interim report, want to express my support for properly regulated fracling to be allowed to proceed.

I am concerned that the media is preoccupied by those who oppose fracing and I think this gives a distorted view of what the broader NT population thinks of the technology and the debate.

I also think those opposing it are combining opposition to fracing with greenhouse gas emissions - using the latter to add weight to their opposition.

As I said, I for one am supportive of it - I know Pam Valley was "fracked" at some stage in order to stimulate flow and wells at Mereenie have had workovers which are similar to fracing in intent.

Also of issue is that those opposing fracing are using emotion rather than reason to support their position - it is very hard to argue logic when it is faced by emotion but the Government will need to do this if it allows fracing to re-commence.
