Thank you for your response.

We have the transcript from the hearing (available here: <https://frackinginquiry.nt.gov.au/?a=441648>) where Naomi Hogan from Lock the Gate made the following statement:

"I note that Consolidated Pastoral Company who own the pastoral station around that area have commissioned water studies as part of their conservation covenant and they say that those studies are happening now so I don't think we can jump ahead and say it's a low risk area. I think there are studies undertaken now that will help the deliberations into the future and certainly there are some qualities there that need further investigation in regards to bird life."

On page 17 Justice Pepper also says that she would like to see the water studies that are being completed, to which Naomi replied *"they're just undertaking them now, so they haven't finished it"*.

Please advise if you have any further comment on the above. In light of your email below I suspect there is a misunderstanding somewhere.

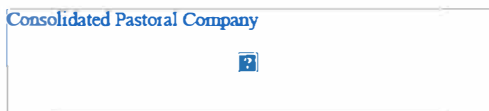
